We started **twenty-three** churches in 2018 and so far, **One** in 2019

We had **Five** churches affiliate with CNBC in 2018 and in 2019 YTD we have **Six** churches that have affiliated with CNBC

Other Statistics

- Vision Tours continue in each SEND City on an as needed basis. This has slowed down from years past, but God has been faithful in bringing partners to help our plants.
- Assessments in AB and ON this spring. Quebec will have just one assessment in French per year with planters from Quebec who can communicate in English going elsewhere for assessment.

Developments

1. SEND Network Canada paperwork has been officially signed in April 2019. This means that we will be able to identify the SEND Network here in Canada as being Canadian led and structured. Perception was that it has been the US determining everything for us so this will help change that perception.
2. We are actively searching for a full-time catalyst for Calgary with some strong candidates in process
3. We are looking for a full-time catalyst for Northern Alberta
4. SEND Network Gathering was in Toronto April 1-2nd. There were over 130 in attendance with representation from Coast to Coast. It was a very important development in the collegiality and sense of togetherness that we are CNBC for the planters. We look forward to gathering again in Sept 2020 in Calgary.
